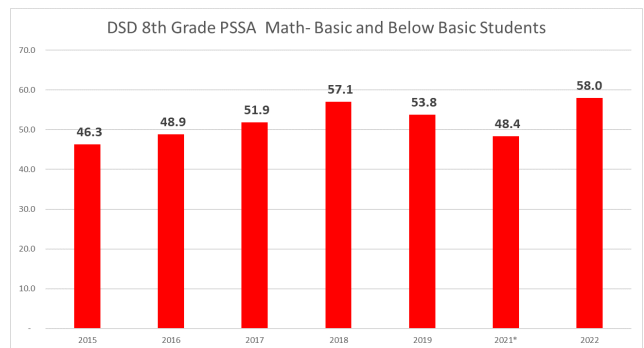
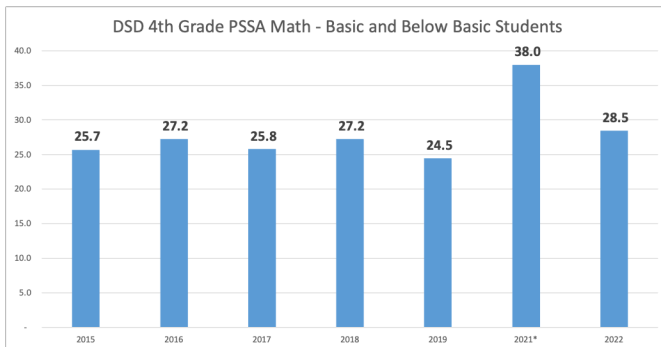

"Although the district's per-student expenditures, bolstered by yearly tax increases of 2% (2022), 3% (2023), and 3.5% for 2024, are at an all-time high (and plans to raise your taxes 3.5% per year over the following five years), Downingtown has experienced a disturbing decline in academic standards. PSSA test scores in 5 out of 10 of the district's middle schools scored 20% below proficiency in English Language Arts, with the data also indicating that over 50% of DASD students are not proficient in 8th-grade math. With such low proficiencies, students are leading to a lifelong educational deficit. We need to find out why.

I have decades of experience in budgeting, complying with regulations, managing employees, and customer service. My professional experience in service management aligns well with the responsibilities of a school board director. I will bring innovative ideas and positive solutions to the district's issues while managing resources and large-scale budgets and expenditures. I will fight to return the community to academic excellence, starting with reviving the foundations of reading, writing, and math."
